Our services include capital and maintenance dredging, installation of stones for scour protection and geotechnical stability, construction and repair of breakwaters as well as a full multibeam survey package. We handle anything from small routine dredging jobs up to multi-million development projects over several months.

Our fleet of six vessels are equipped with either backhoe hydraulic excavators or wire excavators with grabs, all suitable for dredging activities or placing of rock materials.

The vessels have fixed holds for transportation of materials and the PDS2000 guidance system enables us to accurately dredge or place rock.

Stockholm, Värtahamnen (S)	2016	Installation of 10,000 m ³ scour protection and 10,000 m ² geotextile

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
